PUZZLE PIECE MYSTERY BOOK PROJECT

Mystery stories are written puzzles made for a reader. To complete this project, you will make a nine-piece puzzle that gives the reader clues about the story you have read independently.

Materials Needed:

- Puzzle pieces (made in class)
- Color pencils or markers or stickers
- ½ sheet of poster board

Instructions:

- I. Number your pieces I-9.
- 2. On piece #I should be a creative display of the title and author of the book as well as your name.
- 3. Piece #2 should tell the reader about the main character and secondary characters in your book as well as include a picture of the main character.
- 4. Piece #3 should tell the reader about the setting of the book.
- 5. Piece #4 should tell the reader the problem of the book.
- 6. Piece #5 should tell the reader about the main events of the book.
- 7. Piece #6 should tell the reader about the climax of the book.
- 8. Piece #7 should tell the reader three clues about the problem of the book.
- 9. Piece #8 should give a hint of the solution of the problem but not give away the ending. Piece #9 should be your personal rating of the book.
- 10. Put your pieces together on the posterboard. Decorate the edges in the theme of your book.
